Odorless monomers are not ethyl methacrylate-based, so their consistency is thicker and the way they penetrate the powder is slower, which gives you more working time.

Used too wet, the product can run into the cuticle and side-walls. Excess monomer also can make the tacky layer that forms on top of the cured product thicker.

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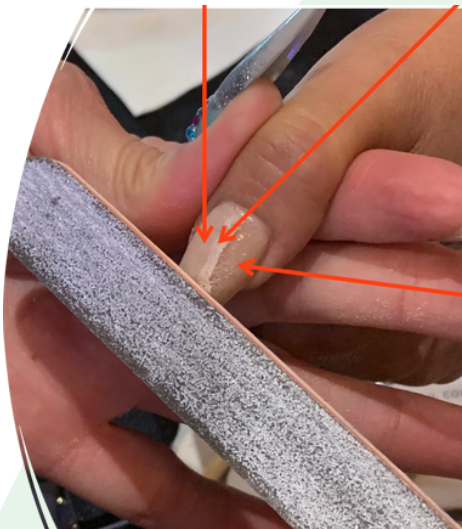

Step by step

Sanitize your hands and then your client hands using Cuccio Pro™ Antibacterial Cleansing Spray. Before you begin application, you must perform a prep manicure. Remove excess cuticle from the nail plate. Buff off the natural shine with a buffer. Clean all the dust off the nails

1. Using the 180/220 grit file, gently remove the shine off the nail bed in the direction from cuticle towards the free edge
2. Clean nail with a new nail brush. Make sure there is no loose debris on the nail plate, as this will cause lifting.
3. Apply Cuccio Pro™ Primer to the nail plate only, being careful not to touch the skin or cuticle. Allow to air dry to a chalky white. NOTE: Should your client experience a reaction to primer, mix 2 oz. of water to a tablespoon of Baking Soda; and apply to the nail/skin where the reaction is taking place. This will neutralize any primer reaction, as primer is an acid.
4. Apply nail tips to all 10 nails.
5. Cut to desired length and shape. Blend the tip well (if there is one).
6. Pour Cuccio Pro™ Odorless liquid into a dappen dish. You should only pour enough for your client. Any left over liquid should be thrown away at the end of the service.
7. Dip the brush into the liquid lightly, wipe excess liquid and dip into your Cuccio Pro™ Odorless clear powder. Make a ball using the tip of the brush. The size of the ball will depend on the size of the area of the nail you are covering and the desired length.
8. Apply a ball of clear powder in the cuticle area.
9. Place the next ball in the middle of the nail this will create the arch of the nail.
10. Pick up your final ball for the free edge. Gently move the product to cover the entire nail and allow it to self-level.
11. File Right to Left (if you are right handed) or Left to Right (if you are left handed) using a 180-grit file, the gummy layer will roll off. Be very careful not to overfile. Do not file back and forth or the gummy layer will stick to the grit on the file. Finish with a buffer block to remove scratches.
12. Finish with a Cuccio Naturalé™ Cuticle Revitalizing Oil.

After application the nail will have a sticky layer follow step 11 to remove the sticky layer, see picture for reference.
